14	In an order filed March 24, 2010, the Court remanded this case to state court, holding that the		
15	removal was untimely and that there is no basis for jurisdiction over this unlawful detainer action. On		
16	March 25, 2010, defendant filed an "Emergency Request for Stay of Order, Objection, Request for		
17	Reconsideration." Defendant states that the removal was in fact timely because her bankruptcy filing		
18	somehow tolled the time to file a notice of removal. Defendant does not cite any authority for this		
19	proposition. However, regardless of whether the removal was timely, the fact remains that defendant		
20	has not demonstrated any basis for this Court's jurisdiction.		
21	Accordingly, defendant's motion is DENIED. Defendant is instructed not to file any further		
22	pleadings in this closed case.
