20 Plaintiff Lehman Brothers Holdings, Inc ("LBHI") filed a  
21 motion for default judgment on May 17, 2010. Doc #18. In support  
22 of its motion, LBHI submitted the declaration of Zachary Trumpp,  
23 who appears to have calculated LBHI's proposed damages. Doc #18-2.  
24 For the loans ending in 6421 and 4271, Trumpp's declaration  
25 sufficiently explains LBHI's damage calculations with references to  
26 the record. See, e g, id at ¶¶6-7. For the remaining three loans  
27 in issue, however, Trumpp's declaration does not provide with  
28 sufficient clarity the damages sought.

1           Using paragraphs 6 and 7 of Trumpp's declaration as a  
2 guide, LBHI shall submit a supplemental memorandum discussing its  
3 damages calculations with respect to each loan in issue. This  
4 submission shall reference relevant documents by exhibit and page  
5 number as was done with loans numbered 6421 and 4271. Where  
6 appropriate, LBHI may highlight specific financial entries in its  
7 submission. To be clear, the court is not looking for an elaborate  
8 submission; rather, it merely requests that LBHI outline its  
9 precise calculations on a loan-by-loan basis.

10           The hearing scheduled for Tuesday, July 6, 2010 is HEREBY  
11 VACATED. LBHI's supplemental memorandum, which should be  
12 accompanied by an updated proposed order and form of judgment,  
13 shall be filed on or before Thursday, July 22, 2010, at which time  
14 the matter will be submitted.
