- 6. Accordingly, the parties hereto respectfully request that the Case Management Conference, currently scheduled for July 9, 2010, be continued for approximately 60 days to allow Defendants to provide Plaintiffs with their calculations; for the auditor to review and analyze those results; for an audit report to be issued and reviewed by Defendants; and for any necessary discussion between the parties to ensue, including payment of amounts found due, if any, and to arrange a payment plan if necessary. If the matter is thereby resolved, Plaintiffs will dismiss this action; if not, Plaintiffs will take further appropriate action, to be determined upon any dispute that is not otherwise resolved.
