10 Cunningham and Teresa Knight;

11 Each side is to bear its own attorneys' fees and costs;

12 All parties release all other parties from all claims pertaining to the life insurance
13 proceeds deposited with the Court in this action; and

14 All parties agree to dismissal of this action with prejudice.

15 Therefore, having settled this dispute and having agreed to dismissal of this action with
16 prejudice, the parties respectfully request that an Order for Dismissal with prejudice be entered.


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ORDER
