| 14 | The second revised settlement agreement filed on August 18 (Dkt. No. 224-1) succeeds in |
| 15 | correcting all problems identified at the August 11 preliminary approval hearing. Accordingly, a |
| 16 | final settlement approval hearing is SET for 3:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2011, in |
| 17 | <u>Courtroom 8</u> . The motion for final approval must be filed by OCTOBER 24, 2011 . The settlement |
| 18 | notice to existing class members shall be mailed by AUGUST 25, 2011, and it must be revised to |
| 19 20 | reflect that the hearing will take place in Courtroom 8, not Courtroom 9. |
| 20 | As to the newly discovered class members, the form of notice submitted on August 15 |
| 21 | (Dkt. No. 222-2) must be mailed by AUGUST 31, 2011, regardless whether a settlement agreement |
| 22 | is reached. Notice of the settlement would not be sent until preliminary approval is granted after |
| 23 | a preliminary fairness hearing. Notice of the class action must be sent promptly and should not be |
| 25 | held up by any potential settlement. The notice must accurately state the time, date, <i>and location</i> |
| 26 | of the November 7 hearing. |
