

1 2. Plaintiff's counsel is lead counsel in an EEOC hearing scheduled for July 12 through July 16,
2 2010, which cannot be continued due to the fact that witnesses have been scheduled to testify
3 at government expense from Korea, Iraq, Afghanistan, the state of Washington, and the state of
4 Georgia.

5 3. The parties, therefore, request that the ICMC be continued until July 23, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. or
6 as soon thereafter as can be scheduled by the court.
