3	2) Plaintiffs may serve no more than 25 total Interrogatories for each Opt-In Plaintiff who is
4	deposed.
5	3) Plaintiffs may serve no more than 40 additional Requests for Production of Documents for
6	each Opt-In Plaintiff who is deposed.
7	4) Plaintiffs may serve no more than 25 total Requests for Admission.

9	These limitations do not limit the evidence, witnesses, or testimony either party may use
10	in motion practice or at trial in this matter, subject to any Order of this Court, the Local Rules of
11	this Court, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Federal Rules of Evidence.
12	Except as outlined here, the Court's April 15, 2011 Supplemental Case Management
13	Order shall remain in effect.
