(Dkt. #19.) In his motion, Mr. Isola directs the Court's attention to a similar case 12 in this district, which the Honorable Richard Seeborg transferred to the bankruptcy court. See 13 Gilbert v. MDK Motor Sports, LLC, C-10-1511 RS, Order Transferring Action to Bankruptcy Court, 14 Dkt. #34. In that case, Judge Seeborg found that the notice of removal was initially drafted with the 15 understanding that it would be filed in the bankruptcy court, although that paragraph (96) had been 16 crossed out by hand. Here, too, the notice of removal was drafted with the understanding that it 17 would be filed in the bankruptcy court, and that paragraph (also ¶6) has been crossed out by hand. 18 As in the Gilbert matter, it appears that this case should have been removed to the bankruptcy court. 19 See In re Eyecare of So. California, 258 B.R. 765, 768 (2001); General Order 24. Accordingly, 20 good cause appearing, this action is hereby transferred to the bankruptcy court for the Northern 21 District of California pursuant to the referral of bankruptcy matters found in General Order 24.
