9 Upon review of the record in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a written
10 consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to
11 Magistrate Judge James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the
12 magistrate judges of this district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil
13 case, including trial and entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a
14 judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of
15 Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district
16 court.

17 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
18 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether it consents to Magistrate Judge
19 James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of
20 both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's
21 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left
22 margin, then choose "Civil." The consent/declination form shall be filed by May 13, 2010.
