Defendant has violated General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders, 21 however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of each document 22 that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the 23 24 judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File." See General Order 45 25 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders for Civil Cases Assigned to the Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2. 26

27 Defendant is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
28 Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced

5	been timely provided to the Court.
