18 and set for hearing no later than May 13, 2011 at 9:00 AM.

19 PRETRIAL CONFERENCE DATE: July 19, 2011 at 3:30 PM.

20 JURY TRIAL DATE: August 1, 2010 at 8:30 AM.,
Courtroom 10, 19th floor.

22 SPECIAL DISCOVERY AND PRETRIAL PROVISIONS:

23 The parties agree that deft may depose plaintiff for 13 hours and that pltf. may depose a defense witness
