

1 That on April 20, 2011, plaintiff's counsel further advised that Flores was not available to
2 appear at the second mediation session rescheduled at his request to May 23, 2011.

3 That due to Flores' recent incarceration related to revocation of his state parole, that he
4 will not be available to participate in the within action, including mediation, until his projected
5 release on or about July 18, 2011.

6 That in the interests of judicial economy, the parties request that the deadline to complete
7 the mediation in this matter be extended to August 31, 2011, and that the case management
8 conference currently scheduled for June 9, 2011 be reset to a date after the completion of said
9 mediation.
