In light of the parties' failure to timely file a Joint Statement, the Court finds a Case

Management Conference premature at this time. Accordingly, the Court VACATES the July 11

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1	Conference. Further, the Court hereby orders Plaintiff and Third-Party Plaintiff to appear in
2	Courtroom No. 15, 18th Floor, United States District Court, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San
3	Francisco, California on September 12, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. to show cause, if any, by actual
4	appearance in Court, and by separate certifications from Plaintiff and Third-Party Plaintiff filed with
5	the Court on or before September 2, 2011 , why the Complaint and Third-Party Complaint should
6	not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. The certifications shall set forth in factual summary the
7	reason no Joint Case Management Conference Statement has been filed and what steps Plaintiff and
8	Third-Party Plaintiff are taking to prosecute their respective Complaints.
9	Failure to comply with any part of this Order will be deemed sufficient grounds to dismiss
10	the action pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b) which is a dismiss on the merits.
