**THIRD ORDER DIRECTING
PARTIES TO FILE
CONSENT/DECLINATION FORM**

On September 1, 2010, the Court issued a second order for the parties to file written consents to the undersigned's jurisdiction or requests for reassignment to a district court judge, with a deadline of September 16, 2010. (Dkt. #10.) None of the parties have complied with the September 1 order. The Court reminds the parties that failure to comply with a court order may result in the imposition of sanctions, and the parties have now failed to comply with two court orders. Accordingly, the parties are ORDERED to inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left margin, then choose "Civil." The parties shall inform the Court of their decision by September 23, 2010.
