 10 Pending before the Court is Defendant's motion to dismiss. Upon review of the record in
 11 this action, the Court notes that the parties have not filed written consents to Magistrate Judge

 13 purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this district
 14 court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and entry of
 15 final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate
 16 Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the
 17 same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

18 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 19 disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the court, by way of the enclosed form (or the
 20 form on the Court's website), whether they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or
 21 request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. The parties shall inform the Court of
 22 their decision by September 2, 2010.
