**SECOND ORDER DIRECTING
 PLAINTIFF TO FILE
 CONSENT/DECLINATION FORM**

 10 On August 9, 2010, the Court ordered the parties to inform it as to whether they consent to
 11 Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction in this case by September 2, 2010. (Dkt. #7.) Plaintiff Carol
 12 Munene has failed to respond. This civil case was randomly assigned to Magistrate Judge James for
 13 all purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this
 14 district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and
 15 entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by
 16 Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth
 17 Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

18 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 19 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff Carol Munene shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed
 20 form, whether she consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a
 21 United States District Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by September 23,
 22 2010. As this is the second such order, Plaintiff should be mindful that sanctions may be imposed
 23 for failure to comply with court orders.
