15	On October 18, 2010, this Court issued an Order granting the Federal Deposit Insurance	
16	Corporation's motion to substitute in as receiver for Indymac Federal Bank, FSB, and stayed	
17	this matter for a period of ninety days. Although the Court denied as moot a motion for refund	
18	of filing fees filed by the FDIC, there has been no further activity since that time, and more than	
19	ninety days have now passed.	
20	Accordingly, the FDIC is HEREBY ORDERED to show cause as to why the stay should	
21	not be lifted. The FDIC's response shall be due by no later than March 11, 2011. If, after	
22	reviewing the FDIC's response, the Court believes a response from any other party is necessary	
23	it shall issue a further order.
