**ORACLE'S STATEMENT OF
ISSUES REGARDING COPYRIGHT**

1 Pursuant to the Court's request (ECF No. 854), Oracle America, Inc. hereby provides the
2 following summary of its copyright infringement allegations to be tried:

3 **What Oracle accuses of copyright infringement are:**

4 1. The Android documentation for the 37 API packages listed below, including the
5 selection, arrangement, and structure of all API elements (including names) in that
6 documentation. Oracle alleges that Google copied an estimated 103,400 lines¹ from the Java API
7 specifications into Android's documentation.

18 2. The selection, arrangement, and structure of all API elements (including names) of the
19 Android class library source code and object code that implements the 37 API packages.

20 3. The declarations of the API elements in the Android class library source code and
21 object code that implements the 37 API packages.

22 4. The Android class library source code and object code that implements the 37 API
23 packages as derivative works of the Java API specifications, including the English-language
24 descriptions.

25 5. Two Android source code files (and corresponding object code), TimSort.java and
26 ComparableTimSort.java, which are part of Android's implementation of the 37 API packages.

27 ¹ Oracle calculated this estimate by counting the lines of a sample of the Android documentation.

1 6. Eight Android source code files (and corresponding object code), AclEntryImpl.java,
2 AclImpl.java, GroupImpl.java, OwnerImpl.java, PermissionImpl.java, PrincipalImpl.java,
3 PolicyNodeImpl.java, AclEnumerator.java, which are not part of Android's implementation of
4 the 37 API packages.

5 7. Comments contained in two Android source code files, CodeSourceTest.java and
6 CollectionCertStoreParametersTest.java, which are not part of Android's implementation of the
7 37 API packages.

8 The tangible medium or media of expression in which the above are fixed are electronic
9 storage media and printed documentation.

10 **What Oracle does not accuse of copyright infringement are:**

- 11 1. Android's use of the Java programming language.
- 12 2. Any particular name of an API element, including names for each package, class,
13 exception, field, method, and parameter name, considered individually.
- 14 3. The Android source code implementing the APIs contained in the 37 packages at the
15 line-by-line level, except as set forth above.
- 16 4. The idea of APIs.
- 17 5. The Dalvik virtual machine (without associated class libraries).
- 18 6. Android API packages and associated class libraries other than the 37 API packages
19 and associated class libraries listed above.
- 20 7. Other Android source code and object code except as set forth above.
