Petitioner, a state prisoner incarcerated at the Correctional Training Facility in Soledad, California, has filed a pro se petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 challenging the California Board of Parole Hearings' ("BPH") June 24, 2008 decision to deny him parole.

**BACKGROUND**

On March 16, 1990, petitioner was sentenced to an indeterminate term of 17 years to life in state prison after a jury in Sacramento County Superior Court found him guilty of second degree murder with use of a firearm.

Petitioner has been found not suitable for parole each time he has appeared before the BPH. On December 17, 2009, the Supreme Court of California denied his state habeas challenge to the BPH's decision of June 28, 2008.

**DISCUSSION**



1 habeas corpus should not be issued. Respondent shall file with the answer and  
2 serve on petitioner a copy of all portions of the state trial record that have been  
3 transcribed previously and that are relevant to a determination of the issues  
4 presented by the petition.

5 3. If petitioner wishes to respond to the answer, he shall do so by  
6 filing a traverse with the court and serving it on respondent within 30 days of his  
7 receipt of the answer.
