Before the Court is a motion to intervene from Tanya Thompson, the claimant who initially filed the charge against the defendant with the EEOC. Docket No. 14. 
1. The motion to intervene is **GRANTED**. The hearing scheduled for May 18, 2011 is **VACATED**.
