Petitioner was ordered to, within 30 days, (1) file a complete application to 15 proceed in forma pauperis (IFP), or (2) pay the filing fee, or face dismissal of the action. 16 That time having passed, petitioner has filed an incomplete IFP application, not having filed 17 a certificate of funds signed by an authorized prison officer and a prison trust account 18 statement showing transactions for the last six months. Accordingly, the action is 19 DISMISSED without prejudice to petitioner (1) paying the filing fee of \$5.00, or (2) filing a 20 completed and signed certificate of funds and a prison trust account statement showing 21 transactions for the last six months. Petitioner's motion to proceed IFP (Docket No. 2) is 22 DENIED. The Clerk shall enter judgment in favor of respondents, and close the file. This 23 order terminates Docket No. 2. 24 IT IS SO ORDERED. 25
