An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken 19 directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal 20 from any other judgment of a district court. 21 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and 22 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiffs shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed form, whether 23 they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States

District Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by November 29, 2010.
