disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiffs shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed form, whether
they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States
District Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by October 28, 2010.
