ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

10 On December 7, 2017, Defendants filed a Motion to Dismiss the *Bivens* Claims. Dkt. No.
11 285. Plaintiff Bernardo Mendia did not oppose the Motion. *See* Docket; Civ. L.R. 7-3.
12 Accordingly, the Court ORDERS Plaintiff to show cause why this case should not be dismissed
13 for failure to prosecute and failure to comply with court deadlines. Plaintiff shall file a declaration
14 by January 10, 2018. Notice is hereby provided that failure to file a written response will be
15 deemed an admission that Plaintiff does not intend to oppose Defendants' Motion, and the *Bivens*
16 claims will be dismissed. Thus, it is imperative that the Court receive a written response by the
17 deadline above.
