## SECOND ORDER DIRECTING TO FILE CONSENT/DECLINATION FORM

Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed form, whether he 23 consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District 24 Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by October 14, 2010.
