Plaintiff has filed a request that his application for order shortening time, motion for relief to file documents under seal, and motion for leave, reconsideration, and removal be referred to the general duty judge. As to the application for order shortening time, this request is **DENIED AS**UNNECESSARY. Under Civil Local Rule 7-9, it is unnecessary to shorten time because plaintiff must first be granted leave to file a motion for reconsideration, and no response need be filed and no hearing will be held concerning a motion for leave to file a motion to reconsider.
