17 Now pending is a Motion to Dismiss filed by Defendant Kamala D. Harris. See dckt.
 18 no. 32. The hearing on that Motion is set for Friday, April 8, 2011. Plaintiff's Opposition to
 19 that Motion was due on March 18, 2011. See Civil Local Rule 7-3 (opposition to be served
 20 "not less than 21 days before the hearing date"). Plaintiff has failed to file an Opposition, or
 21 to respond to correspondence from the Court. Accordingly, Plaintiff is ORDERED TO
 22 SHOW CAUSE by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 30, 2011** why this case should not be
 23 dismissed for failure to prosecute pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). Failure
 24 to timely respond to this Order could result in dismissal of Plaintiff's case.
