Plaintiff has now moved to 19 20 strike all twenty-one of Defendants' affirmative defenses. Mot. to Strike (dckt. no. 13). 21 Defendants opposed the motion (dckt. no. 19) and Plaintiff filed a reply (dckt. no. 21). Having carefully considered the papers submitted by the parties, the Court GRANTS 22 Plaintiff's Motion to Strike. All of Defendants' affirmative defenses are stricken with 23 prejudice, except for Defendants' Eighth, Fifteenth, Eighteenth, and Nineteenth affirmative 24

defenses, which are stricken without prejudice.
