8	Complaint currently set for December 16, 2010;		
9	5.	Hilliard has 20 days from the date of I	notice of entry of an order from the Court accepting
10		and approving this stipulation in its en	tirety to answer the Complaint; and
11	6. Nothing in this stipulation and order bars any other claim set forth in the Complaint and		
12		any defense available to Hilliard or an	y other Defendant in this action.
