9 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's application to take immediate discovery. Upon review
 10 of the record in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a written consent to Magistrate
 11 Judge James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to Magistrate Judge James for all
 12 purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this district
 13 court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and entry of
 14 final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate
 15 Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the
 16 same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

17 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 18 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether it consents to Magistrate Judge
 19 James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of
 20 both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's
 21 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left
 22 margin, then choose "Civil." The consent/declination form shall be filed by January 25, 2011.
