An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge 18 James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same 19 manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

20 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and 21 disposition. Accordingly, Defendant shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed form, whether 22 he consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States 23 District Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by November 30, 2010.
