It appears that plaintiff Tria Beauty Inc. may have misunderstood defendant Radiancy, Inc.'s position regarding the utility of further meet and confer efforts to resolve the issues raised in Plaintiff's motion to compel (Doc. No. 55). As Defendant appears willing to engage in further meet and confer efforts regarding the contested discovery and implies that such meet and confer efforts would be productive, the Court orders the parties to meet and confer once more¹, in person, in advance of the September 27, 2011 discovery hearing. If it is more convenient, the parties may choose to meet and confer on September 27, 2011 in courtroom 14 on the 18th floor of the United States District Court in San Francisco at 9:00 a.m., and continue the hearing until 11:30 a.m. The parties then may appear by telephone from the San Francisco courtroom for the hearing in Eureka. In light of the parties' eagerness to meet and confer, the Court fully anticipates that the parties will be able to narrow the disputed issues to be addressed at the hearing.

¹ The parties met and conferred in person after Defendant filed its opposition, although they did not resolve or narrow the outstanding issues. See Doc. No. 68 at 1 n.2.
