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This civil action by a prisoner was filed on November 16, 2010. More than 40 days have elapsed; however, plaintiff has not provided the court with the requisite items, or sought an extension of time to do so. Plaintiff's incomplete in forma pauperis application is DENIED and the action is DISMISSED without prejudice.
