Facebook shall have an extension of 30 days, until and including December 6, 2010, to answer, move to dismiss, or otherwise respond to the First Amended Class Action Complaint, without prejudice to stipulating to or seeking additional time in the Northern District of California after this matter is transferred.
- This case shall be transferred from the District of Rhode Island to the Northern District of California pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1406.
- 4. As provided for in the SRR, the laws of the State of California shall govern this case. To the extent the Court determines that there is a choice-of-law question that must be resolved, the choice-of-law rules of the Northern District of California (and not the District of Rhode Island or any other court) shall apply in this case.
