proffered as good cause for the requested continuance:

- The complaint in this matter was filed on December 1, 2010. Subsequent to its filing, counsel cooperatively and diligently developed this case for resolution, disposition or trial through discovery.

 2. This case centers around police practices and, with significance to this request for a continuance of the settlement conference in this matter scheduled for April 10, 2012, plaintiffs' 4th amendment claims arising from the entry into plaintiffs' residence on December 8, 2012, and their detention and arrest on that occasion by law enforcement personnel of the County of Marin and the City and County of San Francisco.
- 3. The parties have filed reciprocal motions for summary judgment and partial summary judgment, principally directed to the aforementioned issues. The court has taken those motions under submission, having vacated the hearing scheduled for April 6, 2012.
- 4. The significance of the pending motions is such that the parties do not believe an effort
 to resolve this case without determination of the pending motions will be fruitful. The
