Staff Sergeant Anthony J. Loverde distinguished himself by meritorious achievement while participating in sustained aerial flight as C-130E/H Loadmaster, 737th Expeditionary Airlift Squadron, 386th Expeditionary Operations Group, 386th Air Expeditionary Wing, Ali Al Salem Air Base, Kuwait, from 16 December 2007 to 23 January 2008. During this period, Sergeant Loverde directly contributed to national security objectives by flying missions in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM. The airmanship and courage of Sergeant Loverde were instrumental in the safe completion of 20 combat missions flown into austere locations with minimal ground support and often in marginal weather. These flights were accomplished in the face of enemy threats to include small arms fire, anti-aircraft artillery and surface to air missiles. Sergeant Loverde's superior ability in the presence of perilous conditions was essential to the safe and timely delivery of combat troops and supplies. The professional ability and outstanding aerial accomplishments of Sergeant Loverde reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
