Defendants would then file a reply brief in support of any dispositive motions filed in response to the First Amended Complaint seven days thereafter, on September 9, 2011. The parties' motions would then be heard on October 13, 2011, if that date is available on the Court's calendar.

Pursuant to Local Rule 6-2 and 7-12, the parties jointly request an order changing the date for the hearing on Plaintiffs' motion for partial summary judgment to October 13, 2011, and an order setting forth the above briefing schedule regarding the parties' motions.
