As noted previously, Mr. Knight has been reinstated into the Navy. Mr. Almy has submitted all of the paperwork for reaccession requested by the Air Force. A decision on Mr. Almy's reaccession application is in process. Mr. Loverde must complete the final steps in the reaccession process, which will require him to submit additional paperwork to the Air Force. After such steps are completed, a decision will be made on Mr. Loverde's application. The parties remain hopeful that the process as to Plaintiff Almy and Plaintiff Loverde will soon be completed.

2. The parties jointly request the Court to make the following Supplemental Case Management Order:

Another Case Management Conference shall be set for May 17, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.

In the interim, the parties shall appear telephonically at the Case Management Conference on March 22, 2012, to answer any further questions the Court may have regarding the status of this case.
