 10 Pending before the Court is Defendant California Nurses Association C.H.E.U.'s motion to
 11 dismiss. Upon review of the record in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff John Shek and
 12 Defendant United States Government National Labor Relations, Region 32, have not filed written
 13 consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to
 14 Magistrate Judge James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the
 15 magistrate judges of this district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil
 16 case, including trial and entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a
 17 judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of
 18 Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district
 19 court.

20 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 21 disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the court, by way of the enclosed form (or the
 22 form on the Court's website), whether they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or
 23 request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. The parties shall inform the Court of
 24 their decision by March 10, 2011.
