17	Based on the Court's review of the Bankruptcy Dockets for the debtors, it appears that the

19	ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE by no later than October 2, 2015, why the Court should not re-	
20	open this matter for purposes of dismissing it for failure to prosecute. If Plaintiff fails to file a	
21	response to this Order to Show Cause by October 2, 2015, the Court shall re-open this matter and	
22	dismiss, without prejudice, for failure to prosecute without further notice to the parties.
