Accordingly, Defendant shall inform the Court, by way of the enclosed form, whether she consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. The consent/declination form shall be filed by April 14, 2011. Failure to comply with this Order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
