14	Petitioner, a California prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a habeas petition pursuant
15	to 28 U.S.C. 2254 challenging his continued detention in state prison. Petitioner is incarcerated
16	at Old Folsom State Prison in Represa, California, and he was convicted in Sacramento County
17	Superior Court. Venue for a habeas action is proper in either the district of confinement or the
18	district of conviction. 28 U.S.C. 2241(d). Represa and Sacramento are within the venue of the
19	United States District Court for the Eastern District of California. 28 U.S.C. 84. Because
20	petitioner was convicted and is incarcerated in the Eastern District, this case is TRANSFERRED
21	to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California. See 28 U.S.C. § 1406(-
22	a); Habeas L.R. 2254-3(b). Ruling on the application to proceed in forma pauperis (docket
23	number 5) will be deferred to the Eastern District.
24	The Clerk shall transfer this matter forthwith.
