On April 26, 2011, Valerie Shipping, Inc., Nordea Bank Finland PTE Ltd., and the substitute custodian filed a stipulation for movement of vessel to lay berth and repatriation of non-essential crew members. Defendant Korea Line Singapore PTE, Ltd. has not appeared in this action and no party has sought to obtain entry of default. Thus, the proposed stipulation is not signed by all parties. In addition, on April 27, 2011, certain crew members filed an objection to that stipulation, and sought an opportunity to be heard.

The proposed stipulation is DENIED. The Court shall address these matters by way of the motions filed and set for hearing on May 6, 2011. (See Docket Nos. 49, 52, 71.) This Court has ordered that all opposition to these motions shall be due on April 29, 2011. Therefore, if the crew members wish to be heard, they must file an opposition to the motion by April 29, 2011. If the crew members require additional time to file an opposition, they must submit a request

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
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1 demonstrating good cause for additional time.
