2 WHEREAS, defendants shall have forty-five days from the Fund's filing or designation of
3 the amended consolidated complaint in which to move, answer or otherwise respond;

4 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that defendants will file a motion to dismiss the amended
5 consolidated complaint, and that a hearing on that motion is unlikely to be set for hearing until
6 February 2012;

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Reform Act, all proceedings herein are stayed until and
8 unless a motion to dismiss is denied;

9 WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, the parties believe that a case management
10 conference at this point would serve no purpose and would result in the needless expenditure of
11 private and judicial resources, and that the case management conference in this action should be
12 continued to a date after the Court has had an opportunity to consider defendants' anticipated
13 motion to dismiss;

14 IT IS ACCORDINGLY STIPULATED, by and between the undersigned counsel for the
15 parties, that the case management conference presently scheduled for September 9, 2011 be
16 continued until a date convenient for the Court on or after February 9, 2012.
