1 The parties to this matter, through their attorneys of record, do hereby stipulate as follows:

2 1. The initial Case Management Conference in this case was scheduled for July 13,  
3 2011. On May 24, 2011, the Court vacated the Case Management Conference and stayed  
4 proceedings while the parties pursued mediation. The Court has subsequently four times granted  
5 the parties' request to continue the Case Management Conference to accommodate their post-  
6 mediation settlement efforts. The parties are currently scheduled to appear for a Case

8 2. The parties have neared agreement on the material terms of a proposed class action
