1 Having considered the Stipulation Re: Settlement of Class and Collective Actions
2 (“Stipulation”) and all other materials properly before the Court, and having conducted an
3 inquiry pursuant to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 23 and 29 U.S.C. § 216(b), the
4 Court finds that the Stipulation was entered by all parties in good faith, and the Stipulation is
