**ORDER RE: FAILURE TO COMPLY
WITH REASSIGNMENT ORDER AND
SETTING CASE MANAGEMENT
CONFERENCE**

15 By order of this Court dated February 11, 2013, the parties were required to submit a joint
16 case management statement within fifteen days of the reassignment of the above-captioned action
17 to this Court. Dkt. No. 45. The parties failed to comply with that Order, although the Court notes
18 that Plaintiff has now submitted a case management statement thirty one days after the
19 reassignment order was issued. Dkt. No. 47. The parties are advised that further violations of
20 orders of this Court may result in monetary or other sanctions.

21 The parties are hereby ordered to appear, in person, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil
22 Procedure 16 and Civil Local Rule 16-10(c), for a case management conference to be held in this
23 action before the Honorable Jon S. Tigar on April 17, 2013, at 2:00 P.M. in Courtroom 9, 19th
24 Floor, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102. Each party shall appear personally or
25 by counsel having authority to enter into stipulations and make admissions pursuant to this Order.
26 Written requests to reschedule the case management conference or to appear telephonically will be
27 granted sparingly and only upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances.


28 The parties shall file a joint case management statement no later than five court days from
