
**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANTS’

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(a) and Civil Local Rule 72-2, defendants Amazon.com, Inc. and Barnes & Noble, Inc. have separately moved for relief from Magistrate Judge Westmore’s February 26, 2013 Order Permitting Discovery of Sales Information for Non-Accused Products.
