18	letter or envelope, the objection is overruled. Defendants shall ensure that the transportation letter	
19	includes the attachments referenced in the letter (i.e., the Court order and the Mulraney declaration)	
20	To the extent Defendants ask the Court to order Plaintiff to mail the old transportation letter	
21	new photos, etc. to DHS-USCIS by May 31, 2012, the request is denied without prejudice.	
22	However, until Plaintiff provides Defendants with the information ordered by the Court in its order	
23	of May 18, 2012, see Docket No. 88 (order), Defendants have no obligation to issue a new	
24	transportation letter.
