Before the Court are a variety of motions filed by plaintiffs in an effort to continue the settlement conference presently scheduled for Thursday, November 17, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. Having read the papers submitted, the Court finds no need for argument and DENIES the motions (Docket Nos. 32 and 33).
